Resurfacing S. Grove Avenue (CR 643) **West Deptford Township and Borough of National Park** **From: Woodbury Creek Bridge to Red Bank Avenue (CR 644) 1.06 mi.**

PROJECT BACKGROUND: The County of Gloucester will be continuing the resurfacing project on CR 643 S. Grove Avenue in West Deptford Township and the Borough of National Park. The project is being completed in order to address the deterioration of the existing surface.

THE PROJECT: The project will consist of milling 2 inches of the existing asphalt and overlaying the roadway with 2 inches of a new asphalt surface course. Wheel ruts and other pavement distortions will be removed by this pavement overlay. Existing inlet grates not meeting NJDOT standards will be replaced with new bicycle safety grates. The inlet openings not meeting NJ Storm Water Management Guidelines will be replaced or retrofitted. The concrete sidewalk ramps that do not meet current ADA standards will be replaced. Traffic striping will also be replaced.

The roadway may be detoured but will allow traffic to flow in one direction throughout the length of the project. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained when possible. The daily detour will be posted by the contractor. Residents shall have access to their driveways at all times.

PROJECT STATUS: The project will begin construction on or about Monday, August 6, 2018. We anticipate two days of work, weather permitting.

The hours of the project operation will commence at 6:00 AM and end at 4:00 PM

This project is anticipated to be completed in **2 days, weather permitting.**
